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WHAT IS CURRICULUM MAPPING?

“Curriculum mapping is a process for recording what content and skills are actually taught in a classroom, school, or district during a longer period of time. The data provide an overview, rather than a daily classroom perspective, of what is actually happening over the course of the school year” (Jacobs, 1997).

“Curriculum mapping can serve as both an instrument and a procedure for determining what the curriculum is and monitoring the planned curriculum” (O’Malley, 1982).

Curriculum Mapping:

- A chart or map of the content, skills, and assessments that describe learning in a classroom
- Map of a year’s curriculum in increments (monthly, grading period, etc)
